The top 4 designs will be selected over the winter and next May they will be on display at the market for patrons to weigh in. The results from that will be considered in the final adjudication by a panel of judges (all distinguished community members I might add ;-)) who will make the final decision. Plans are to announce the winner by the end of May 2015. Then they'll be printed and shared with the world!

PARAMETERS

- Text for both sides is on the back of this sheet and must be adhered to.
- Clear and legible design that stands out in a crowd.
- Capture the essence of our unique community-based market.
- Brand colour is a vibrant "goldenrod", like our sandwich boards.
- Winner must be able to supply ready to print digital files & be available for any adjustments/support if required.

WHAT & HOW TO SUBMIT *IMPORTANT*

Print out actual size – 4x6" postcard in full colour, mount front and back on one side of an aprx 8.5"x11" bristol board (or similar). On back of board clearly label your contact info (email, phone, address). Put in envelope and drop off Tampered Press on/by Sunday Nov. 30th, 7pm AND email info@tbfm.ca a digital file.
